

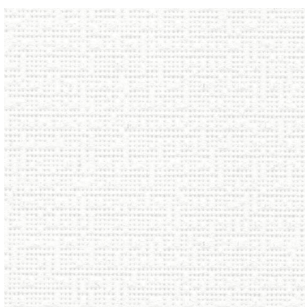

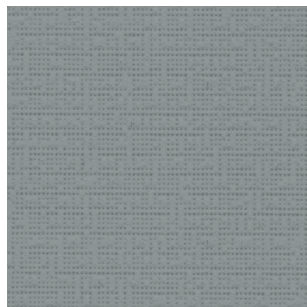

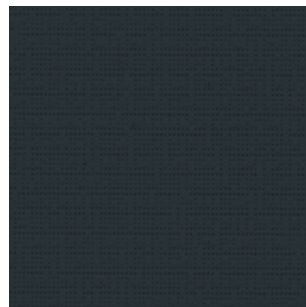

Cleaning and Care

Remove dust and surface dirt regularly with a soft brush, cloth, or by rinsing with clean water. Light, routine cleaning helps preserve both look and performance.

For deeper cleaning, use mild soap with lukewarm water and a soft sponge or cloth. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry. Avoid harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive tools.
